# Eyjafjallajökull

Eyjafjallajökull is Iceland's sixth biggest glacier. It is 1.651 m wide while the peak is 1.666 m

It has erupted four times over its lifetime.

The latest one was March 20th 2010. It also erupted the years 920, 1612 and 1821 which lasted 2 years.
